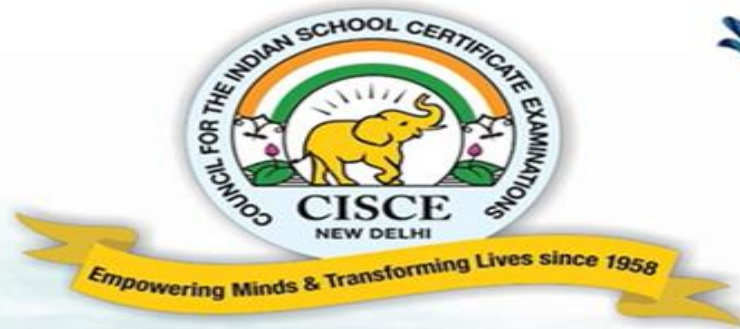

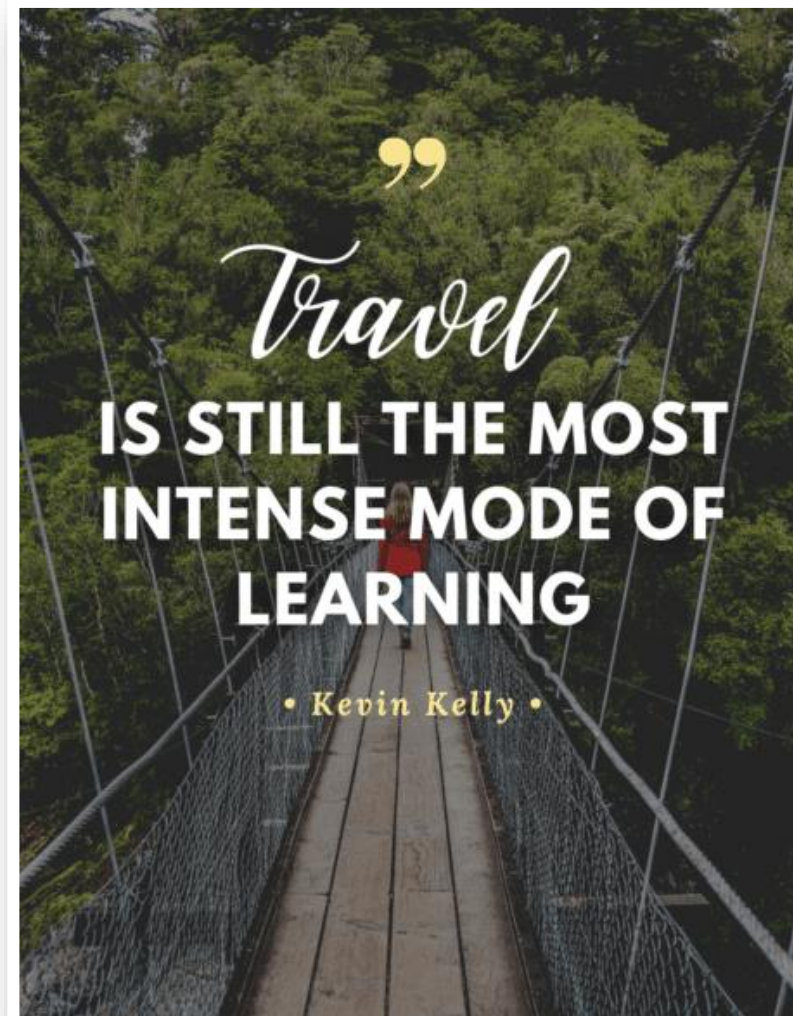












Biology Field Trip to the Horticulture Department

On 3rd October 2025, the ISC Grade 11 Biology students of Hiranandani Foundation School were given a wonderful opportunity to visit the Hiranandani Nursery as part of their experiential learning programme.

The visit enabled the students not only to realize that the leaves, stems, and structures they study in textbooks truly exist in the natural world, but also to appreciate the vastness of the often “unseen world” of plants.

The group departed from school around 10 a.m. and returned by 12 noon. In those two hours, the students gained much more than classroom knowledge. The nursery staff warmly welcomed them and patiently guided them through various sections, explaining plant morphology, adaptations, and modifications with clear, real-life examples. Observing the plants in their natural habitat made the learning process more engaging and memorable.

The visit helped the students understand that plants are far more than just “things that give us oxygen.” They discovered that plants possess remarkable adaptations, ranging from producing poisons that deter predators to developing colourful leaves that compensate for underdeveloped flowers.

Towards the end of the visit, each student was presented with a complimentary plant to nurture at home, thereby extending the learning experience beyond the classroom. It was a simple yet meaningful gesture that left everyone with smiles and a renewed sense of curiosity.

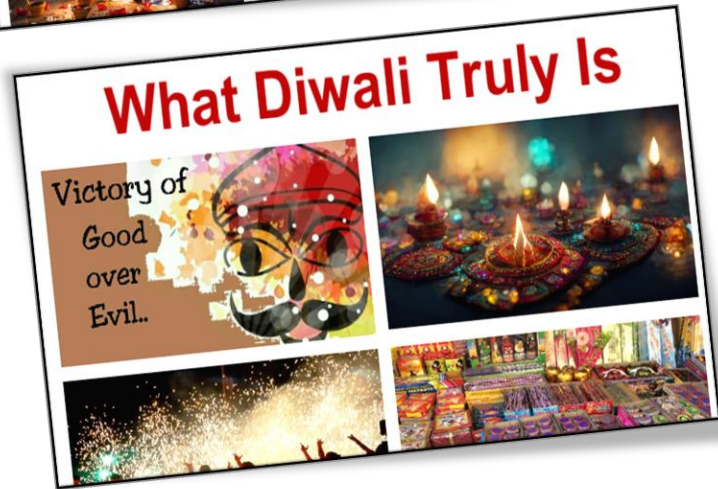

Use and gift Indian made diyas, sweets, clothes and decorations. When we buy local , we don’t just light our homes , we light up someone’s livelihood too !

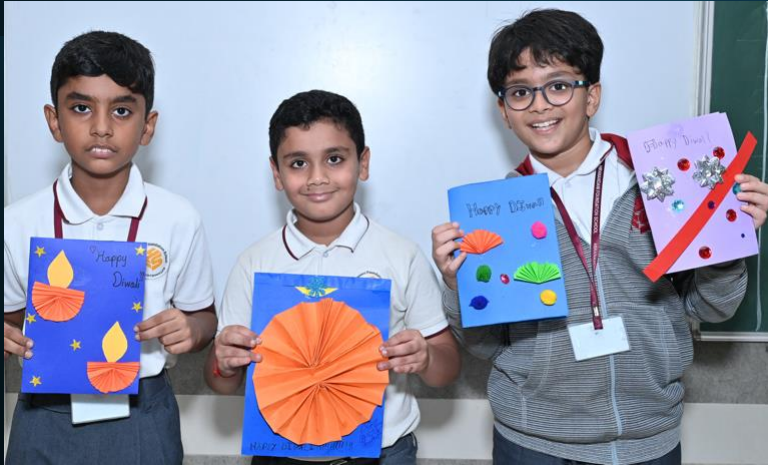
Diwali Celebrations
