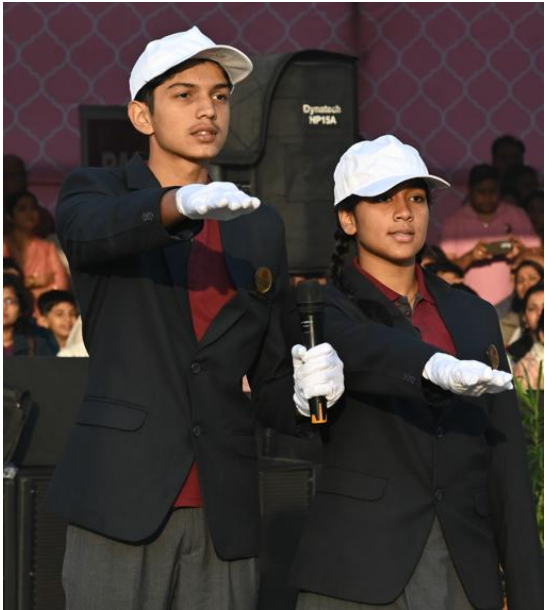
A Day of Triumph- Passion Fuels Performance
